## SBR's Seasonal Service • Seattle's Best 'Tune-up'

Your bike deserves more than a tune-up because your bike needs more than a tune-up. A typical tune-up includes brake and derailleur adjustments, minor wheel truing, some air in your tires and, hopefully, a squirt of lubricated for your chain. This typical tune-up usually costs around \$30-50 and it is \$30-50 wasted.

Once a year every bike will benefit from S.B.R.'s <u>Seasonal Service</u>. This service provides the extra cleaning, lubrication, alignments and adjustments that will prevent premature damage or wear to your bicycle. Your bike will perform better and your investment will be protected.

Here are the highlights of the Seasonal Service and a short explanation of their purpose.

**Drivetrain evaluation and cleaning:** If your chain is stretched or dirty it will damage other drivetrain components. If components are dirty drivetrain and shifting performance will be poor.

Frame evaluation and dropout alignment: Even a minor crash can knock your frame out of alignment. Bent dropouts can cause frame damage and/or axle breakage.

Hub, bottom bracket and headset adjustment: Poorly adjusted bearings cause excess resistance while you are riding and eventual damage to these components.

Wheel truing, rounding, tensioning and dishing: Your wheels take lots of abuse and need lots of attention. Proper tension, truing and rounding ensure maximum performance and durability. Proper dish ensures proper alignment in the frame and proper tracking. S.B.R. also removes and inspects tires, tubes and rim strips to verify their condition and installation.

Brake and gear adjustments: S.B.R. also does more here. Pivots, cables, levers, pulleys, and barrels are lubricated and adjusted. Alignment of the rear derailleur hanger is included to ensure optimal shifting. There in no extra installation charge for new cables, shoes, pulleys and etc. (parts, of course, are extra).

Bicycle Touring is back!! Although it never left R+E Cycles, the enthusiasm for loading up your bike and escaping your everyday life for a few days, weeks or months has not been rampant throughout the cycling industry. R+E has always carried touring bikes, bags, route guides and the zest for cycle touring but this year our selection has gotten even larger.

No one says that you can't put a pair of slick tires on your trusty mountain bike, equip it with panniers and have a

terrific time. However, there are a lot of riders who like the efficiency and feel of a true tour-

ing bike. Clap your hands folks; for 1996 R+E is offering 4 models of bikes specifically designed to handle the demands of everyday loaded riding.

Bianchi has a long time reputation for building great road bikes and they have always included one touring model in their line. This year Bianchi is offering 3 distinctly different models for different styles of touring. We are also excited to offer a sport touring model from Mongoose.

 The Bianchi San Remo at \$1050 is the ultimate touring machine. It is the first time in many years that we have seen a model so well designed for touring. A Campagnolo equipped bike with a triple crankset, this bike more resembles a custom touring bike than a production model. A traditional semi sloping fork crown accommodates wider tires and fenders. This bike is begging to cross state lines.

•The Bianchi Volpe at \$830 comes equipped with Shimano RSX components including STI shifting. (This means the shift levers are integral with the brake levers, making it possible to shift gears without changing your hand position!) It's got low enough gears and enough braze-ons to

> conquer mountain pass!

 The Mongoose Omega is a fan-

tastic value for a \$750 multipurpose machine. This bike gives you the gearing and braking ability to haul some gear on a serious tour, but also provides a little tighter geometry for quicker handling on STP and other supported rides.

 The Bianchi Eros at \$950 (a great credit card touring machine) has already developed a loyal following. This is the 4th year for this model, and again Bianchi has a winner on their hands. This bike is all Italian... including the tubing, the Campagnolo components and the folks in Italy who built it. The Eros is sportier than traditional touring steeds and some people appreciate its zip when they're just riding around.

The '96 cycling season is upon us with warmer, drier, longer days (let's hope). Longer daylight hours means longer training rides for the centuries and tours in the upcoming spring/summer. Let's talk about some of the nutrition principles that will help during training as well as some that will enhance recovery after training.

Hydration- On a daily basis you should be drinking eight glasses of water or fruit juice. If your urine is not clear or pale in color you are under hydrated. During any ride over one hour you should be using a fluid replacement drink such as 'Cytomax'. Drinks like 'Cytomax' are absorbed quicker than just plain water and give your body the calories and electrolytes it needs for longer durations of exercise.

Food for on the bike- As your rides become longer than two hours, food needs to be taken in as well. Depending on body weight and exercise intensity the amount of calories taken in while riding varies. I take in 200-400 calories an hour in food. Usually it is best to eat every 15-30 minutes. One product that has worked very well is 'GU'. GU is an energy packet that you squeeze into your mouth followed by a sip of liquid. GU is absorbed into your system very quickly. 'Power bars' and 'Stoker' bars also work well. Stick with food high in carbohydrates. Be sure that you try everything while training before using it for the big event . You will want to make sure it works well with your own digestive system.

Refueling after training- After finishing a ride your body will be depleted of glycogen. Your body is able to absorb the most glycogen (carbohydrates) in the first two hours after finishing riding. Good choices are bagels, potatoes, and noodles. Your body will thank you in the following days by recovering quicker and allowing you to ride







## N.U.T.S. IS ALIVE & WELL



### TANDEM RIDING 101


