LEARN TO RIDE A TANDEM

MORE FUN THAN DOING THE TANGO??

We think so. Find out for yourself. Spend a few hours in our Tandem 101 Riding class and you'll ride away as a competent tandemist,tandemer, tandemette.

We'll talk a bit about tandems in general, then we'll give some verbal instruction and finally we'll take you out on the road. Just because you are a good bike rider does not mean that you'll be a great captain or stoker the first 100 yards of your ride. We'll start by letting you experience each position with us in the other, before we send you out on a tandem together. Letting 2 people go out together who have never been on a tandem before, is like letting you take out a semi-truck, just because you know how to drive a car.

Sign up for a tandem class and you'll understand why tandem riders smile so much. The price is \$35 per couple paid in advance.

Have you ever wondered how many bicycles the police recover but can not return to the rightful owner? The numbers vary from city to city but the commonality is that they are huge. It is no surprise. Have you ever looked at the serial number that is stamped (somewhere) into your bicycle's frame? It was stamped before it was painted, so the paint usually obscures part of the numbers. It gets pretty hard to tell a 3 from an 8, an S from an 8, etc. Mechanics usually do the best job they can to decipher the numbers when they record them on the form you get. If/when a bike is recovered the police may interpret the numbers (if they can find them) quite differently and then your bike sits with hundreds of others until the department does whatever it does with them.

Wouldn't it be great if you could have an easily readable, but unremovable "license" on your bike? And even better, suppose there was a national site on the internet where all of these numbers were store? That way, when a bike was recovered the police could easily find the owner even if they were in a different city. As it is, if you report your bike stolen in Bellevue, and it turns up in Seattle, it is going to be a long shot to have it returned to you.

Sign up with the National Bike Registry and you'll vastly increase your chances of having a stolen bike recovered. This registry has been in existence since 1984, but with the help of the internet, it has become really valuable. Here's how it works. You fill out a short ID form, pay a small fee, and you receive a virtually unremovable, virtually tamper proof ID sticker for your bicycle. This number is listed on the NBR website, for which police departments, nationwide have access. When they run across a bike with this easily legible number on it , they'll log on to the "net" and you'll have your bike back!

The registration fees are very reasonable and we want to help recover stolen bikes. So, if you register via R+E anytime before March 15, we'll knock \$3 off the cost as listed below:
